Kenexis and ISA Sign Safety Training Marketing and Execution Agreement

Kenexis has been Authorized by ISA – The International Society of Automation – to Market and Execute its SIS Engineering Courses in the United Arab Emirates

Columbus, December 23, 2010: Kenexis today announced that it has signed an agreement with ISA – The International Society of Automation – to market and execute its series of Safety Instrumented System (SIS) engineering courses in the United Arab Emirates. The agreement allows Kenexis to schedule open-enrollment publicly-available sessions of the SIS Engineering series of courses available from ISA. These courses include: EC-50 Safety Instrumented Systems – Design, Analysis, and Justification; EC-52 – Advanced Safety Integrity Level (SIL) Selection; and EC-54 – Advanced Design and SIL Verification. These courses are also part of the ISA84/IEC61511 SIS Certificate Programs, allowing participants with the appropriate pre-requisite experience to obtain up to three certificates to demonstrate competency in the IEC61511/ISA84 standard and associated engineering techniques and procedures.

Kenexis expects to coordinate the marketing and execution of these training courses from their Kenexis DMCC office in Dubai. Current plans call for at least two sessions of all three training courses to be executed in Abu Dhabi during the 2011 calendar year, with additional open-enrollment and private placement courses as required by the demand. A set of courses in Dubai is also a strong possibility. The first course set is tentatively scheduled for the end of the first quarter, with the second set in early autumn.

In addition to marketing the courses, Kenexis will be responsible for execution, providing facilities, and most importantly providing instructors. The instructors for the training courses will taken from the senior ranks of the Kenexis consulting organization, and will primarily be the responsibility of Kenexis
